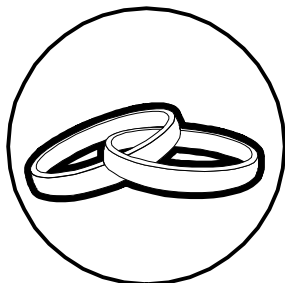

What next?


