Photography at Services – Guidelines

We ask all families taking photographs during our services, in particular weddings and baptisms to observe these guidelines. A hand out of these guidelines is available and will be given to families as part of the wedding and baptism packs, and will be issued on the day as appropriate.

- We do not allow the use of flash photography or additional lighting during the service. During a wedding ceremony flash may be used for the entry of the bride, signing of the register and the exit of the couple only.
- Photographs must be taken unobtrusively during the service and we ask photographers to follow any directions given by the clergy, vergers or church wardens.
- Photographers are not permitted on the platform at the front of the nave.
- Please do not take any photographs of the choir
- We ask that you do not photograph children who are not in your party. This is particularly important at Baptisms and Sunday services where several families may be present.
- Weddings
 - During the signing of the registers photographs are welcome but please restrict these to the bride, groom and immediate attendants.
 - Please move away from the West door as soon as possible and move to another area of the grounds to give space for the following wedding.
