

Thought for the Day

In our readings today, we are taken to the very heart of the mystery of the Incarnation: Jesus is simultaneously the "Son of David" and the "Son of God".

Matthew uses the experience of Joseph - a "righteous man" - who, faced with a scandalous pregnancy, chooses compassion over public shame. By naming and adopting Jesus, he makes the link to David's royal line, fulfilling the prophecy which points to Emmanuel - "*God is with us*".

Paul's introduction to the Romans echoes this, declaring that Jesus was a descendant of David "*according to the flesh*" but was revealed in power as the Son of God through the Resurrection. Together, these texts remind us that God works through both human lineage and divine intervention. Jesus is not just a historical figure; He is the promised Saviour and Messiah - '*God's Anointed One*' - who invites us into a new life of grace and the "obedience of faith."
