## TRINITY 19

*For the one who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one Father. For this reason Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers and sisters, saying 'I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters...' Hebrews 2:11-12*

In the Old Testament, God is described more in metaphorical terms as a father, but in the New Testament the Son speaks of the Father by name; '*will proclaim your name*'.
