

Thought for the Day


This week's Gospel reading brings us the story of Jesus' baptism. There have been several "recognition moments" already - mostly during Jesus' infancy and childhood - but this one is a public declaration, made by God, and tells those listening that Jesus is his son. It really couldn't be plainer.

When Jesus first comes to John for baptism, John is horrified. He knows perfectly well who Jesus is and knows his own need for receiving the Holy Spirit through baptism. But this symbolic baptism is needed so that all those present will recognise Jesus for who he is. Take a moment to cast yourself into the story. You are one of the crowd, perhaps awaiting your own baptism, or having just been baptised, or simply an "interested bystander". You are standing on the banks of the Jordan, and suddenly you hear a voice declaring that "this is my Son, in whom I am well pleased". The voice is not linked to a visible human, and you just know inside yourself that it is God speaking. You take a look at the "Son of God" and recognise him to be the new travelling teacher. How will you respond beside the Jordan? How will you respond here in King's Norton today?


