Don't worry

'Don't worry' are easy words to say. We have so many things that concern us don't we? It might be our health, or that of others, money worries, issues in our families or...or...or... Let's be honest, even our personal list of worries can feel pretty endless. Then there is the state of the world with its wars and conflicts. And of course at this harvest time there is also the state of the planet with all the destruction we see and hear about. How do you know worry if we are in a climate emergency?

Those listening to Jesus had plenty of worries too, but he still tells his listeners to trust God. It's not that our needs and worries are not real or important, but God is bigger and is active in the world.

The answer to worry Jesus offers is that first we are to seek God, and then everything else finds its place. So if you are worrying as you read these words the first step is to be honest. As you pray tell God what is worrying you, even if it's a long list. Then ask that your focus will not be on your worries, but on his endless love that surrounds us each day, even in the middle of our troubles and fears. Go on – try it, and let me know what happens.
